

Instructions:

- 1) Print out all of the pages.
- 2) Get creative! Add colour to each drawing. You can customise the character if you like, draw backgrounds, or perhaps add a new creature in the scene?
- 3) When you have finished colouring each drawing, cut along the lines with scissors.
- 4) Arrange the images in numerical order — you will see the numbers in the top left corner.

You'll Need:

Paper (thicker, drawing paper is best!)

Stapler or cellotape/masking tape

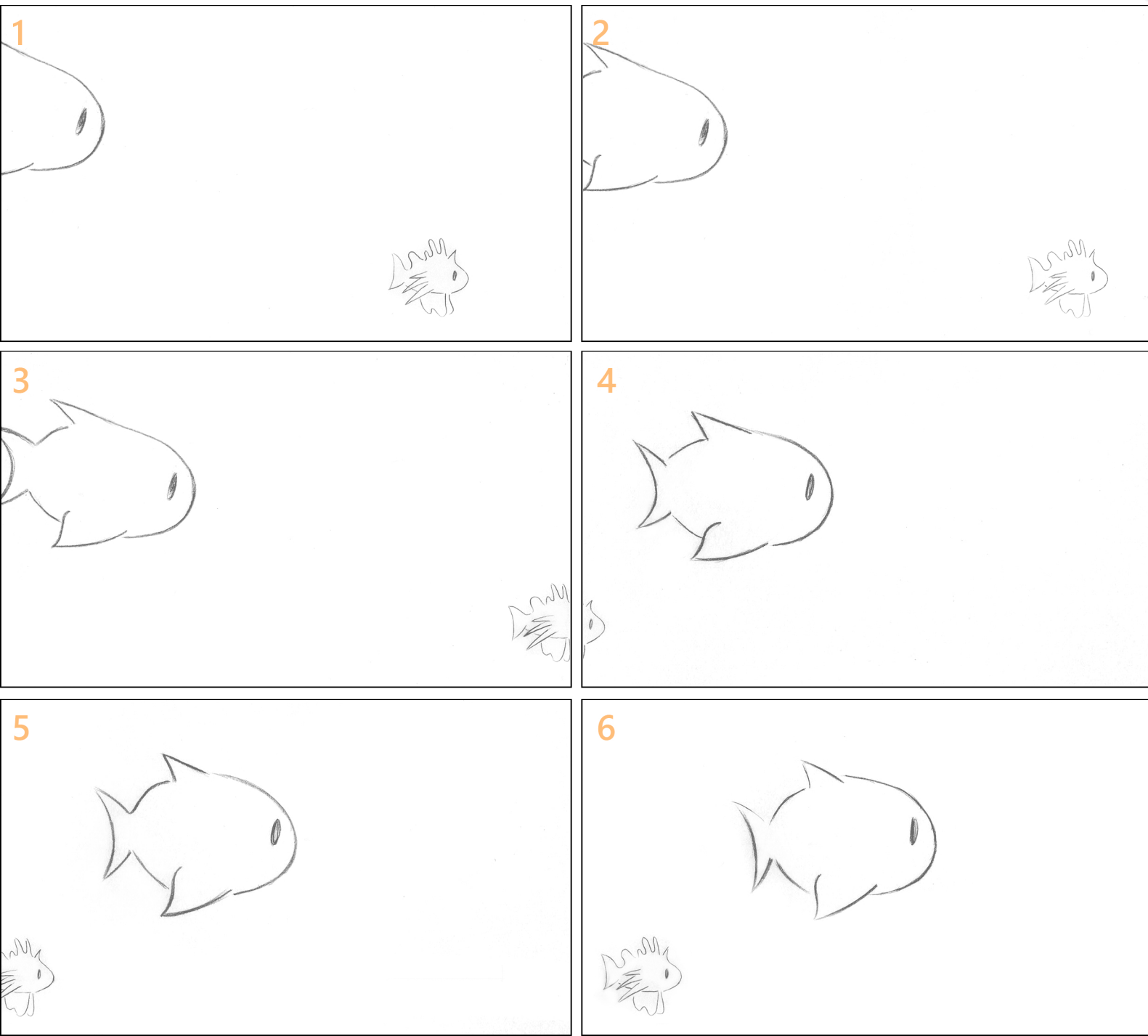
Colouring pencils or pens

Scissors

Printer

Pegs

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Instructions:

5) Once the pages are in a neat stack, use a peg on the left-hand edge. Use your thumb to flip through the pages and watch your sea creatures swim to life!

6) When you're happy with how your flipbook looks, you can replace the pegs with tape, or use a stapler to fix the pages together.

Taadaa! **Your flipbook is complete.**
Now go and make some more!
